

1. Provide examples of the hidden forms of prostitution, and explain to what extent they are recognized and dealt with as such?
 - Hidden in plain sight, there exists varied forms of prostitution in South Korea from Talk Bars to Room Salons¹. Despite the Prostitution Punishment Law², operation of these parlors goes unchecked and tacitly condoned.
9. How effective have legislative frameworks and policies been in preventing and responding to violence against women and girls in prostitution?
 - Survivors of prostitution are entitled to state support according to Article 3 of the Prostitution Prevention Law. However, in the case of adult survivors, only those involuntarily involved in prostitution could get support.
10. What measures are in place to collect and analyse data at the national level with a view to better understanding the impact that prostitution has on the rights of women and girls?
 - Article 4 of the Prostitution Prevention Law³ requires investigation into status of commercial sex acts every three years.
11. What measures are in place to assist and support women and girls who wish to leave prostitution?
 - Housing, shelters, medical care, job training, and financial support are available by government for those who have left prostitution.
